

## ELEMENTARY FULL ADMISSION CHECKLIST

1. Students seeking full admission to a teacher education program must meet the following criteria:

\_\_\_ 30 hours minimum from an accredited institution of higher learning;

\_\_\_ 2.75 grade point average (OU retention);

\_\_\_ 2.75 grade point average (COMB retention).

2. 24 hours with a "C" or better:

\_\_\_ ENGL 1113 - 3 hours

\_\_\_ P SC 1113 - 3 hours

\_\_\_ ENGL 1213 - 3 hours

\_\_\_ BIO/PHYS SCI - 3 hours

\_\_\_ MATH 1473/1503/1523 - 3 hours

\_\_\_ SOC/PSY/ANTH (1113) - 3 hours

\_\_\_ HIST 1483/1493 - 3 hours

\_\_\_ ENGL/PHIL/A HI/MUNM - 3 hours

3. If overall GPA is between 2.75 – 2.99 you **must** take **one** of the following tests.

Oklahoma General Education Test (OGET) (minimum score) **preferred**:

**Exemption:** If overall GPA is at least a 3.00 or higher, you are exempt from testing for full admission.

4. Full Admission Essay:

Full admission to a teacher education program requires the submission of an essay response to the following prompt:

*Describe an exceptional teacher you remember during your time in school. What are some characteristics and attributes that make him/her an exceptional teacher?*

Submit your response in the form of a typed, double-spaced, edited essay that is two-to three pages in length. You will need to provide two copies.

5. After completion of items 1–4, call the Student Services Center (325-2238) to schedule your interview.
6. Full Admission Interview.
7. **Return** to Student Services Center for permission to enroll in education classes.
